To Whom It May Concern:

In July 2005, the Tulsa County Sheriff's Office assumed management and operations of the David L. Moss Criminal Justice Center. This facility houses 1,700 plus inmates and has over 340 full-time employees. One of first concerns was the safety and sanitation of the facility.

We researched for a product that would effectively kill the Methicillin-resistant Staphylococcus aureus or MRSA. Sheriff Glanz and I were introduced to Staphacide. We began using Staphacide to sanitize all mattresses and housing areas at the facility. While we have had individuals brought into the facility with active cases of MRSA, we have been able to control the infection of other inmates and staff members by including the use of Staphacide in our infection control methods.

Controlling the operating costs for the operation of the facility is also a main concern to our office as well as to the tax payers of Tulsa County. We began using Jep-14 as a general cleaning agent. Jep-14 is diluted with water and therefore provides for a more cost effective method of cleaning.

I would highly recommend both products for use where a healthy and safe environment is of top concern.
